Rules and Regulations for serving GCA Board of Trustees as per the new GCA Bylaws;

1. *Should be duly paid member of GCA for 2009*
2. *There will be 5 Board of Trustees posts*
3. ***The individual contesting must have served at least one year on the GCA Executive Committee in the past***
4. *Nominations can be submitted until 15 days prior to the election date. If enough nominations have not been received, then nominations may be submitted from 48 hours before election to on the floor on the day of the election itself. If more than 5 decide to run, there will be a secret ballot election and the highest 5 vote getters will be duly elected.*
5. *Election results will be announced immediately after the counting of the votes is completed*
6. *In case of a tie-in, the reelection will be held immediately.*
7. *Election Day will be announced in either December 09 or January 10*
8. *The contestant must be physically present at the election site on the day of the election.*
9. *Once the 5 members are elected, committee posts will be selected internally by a secret ballot election.*
10. ***Once elected, the term of each trustee will be 2 years, with eligibility to serve for no more than THREE consecutive terms(not counting the interim term, for a total of no more than SIX years, not counting an interim term. An interim term is one when a position is assumed to fill a vacancy.***
11. ***In any matter of controversy, conflict or dispute pertaining the election, the decision by a majority vote of the election committee shall be final, binding and without further recourse, legal or otherwise. The Election Committee is authorized to declare the election valid or invalid for any specific position; and if invalid, the reelection will be held immediately on the same day.***
